

Perform the activity:

Make a video in which you interview your friends, family, among others, with the aim of knowing how they imagine a robot that helps humanity and a killer robot.

These interviews can be done through zoom, hangouts, meet or any other virtual platform. The idea is that you explain a bit about what killer robots are and what the serious implications and risks would be of developing, producing and using them.

Then ask them what they think about it.

Record the sessions using your cell phone camera or a screen video recorder.

Finally, draw conclusions from what they say and invite them to share this information. Remember, the more people we share the risk of what killer robots represent, more closely we will come to our goal of being able to achieve a total ban on these weapons.

Upload the video of the interview to your social networks (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter) and to the platform "Youth Against Killer Robots", post the hashtags:
