



In the following booklet, you will find instructions and guidelines for using the toolkit: <https://youthagainstkillobots.org/>, explaining the components of the website, what the process is for carrying out a series of activities linked to raising awareness and sensitizing young people to the risks and implications of developing, producing and using Killer Robots or Lethal Autonomous Weapons Systems (LAWS), and finally, what the dynamics are for Scouts to get the badge designed and developed exclusively for this project.

The tool is called "Youth Against Robot Killers", a name you will find at the beginning of the process. This way, it has a panel where you will find the "Home", "Activities", "About Us", "Contact", "FAQ", "Registration" and "Access"





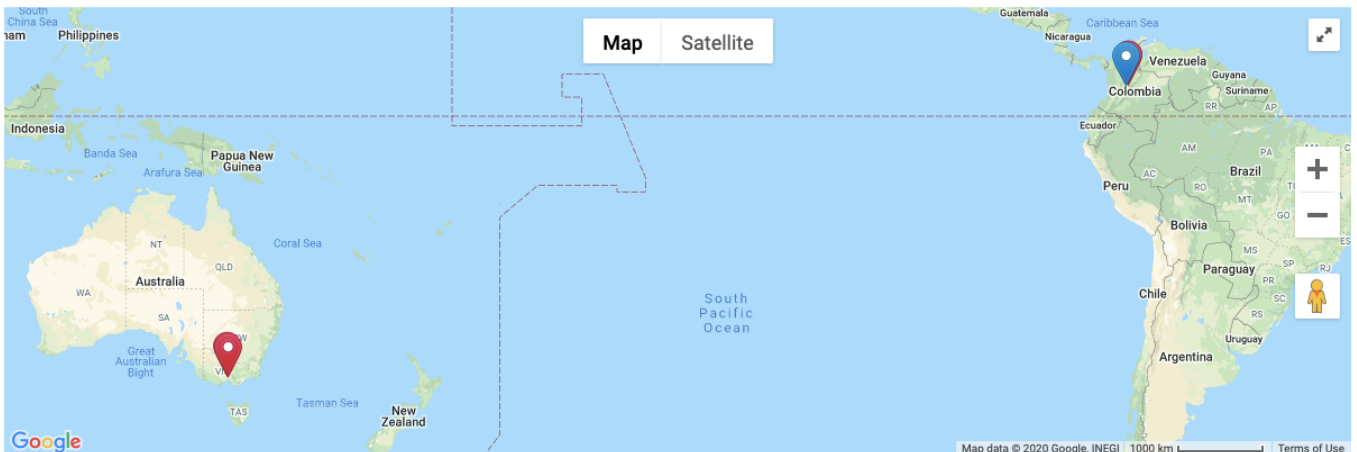
In the "Home" you will find four important sections; first, we welcome you to start the process, along with a call for you to register.

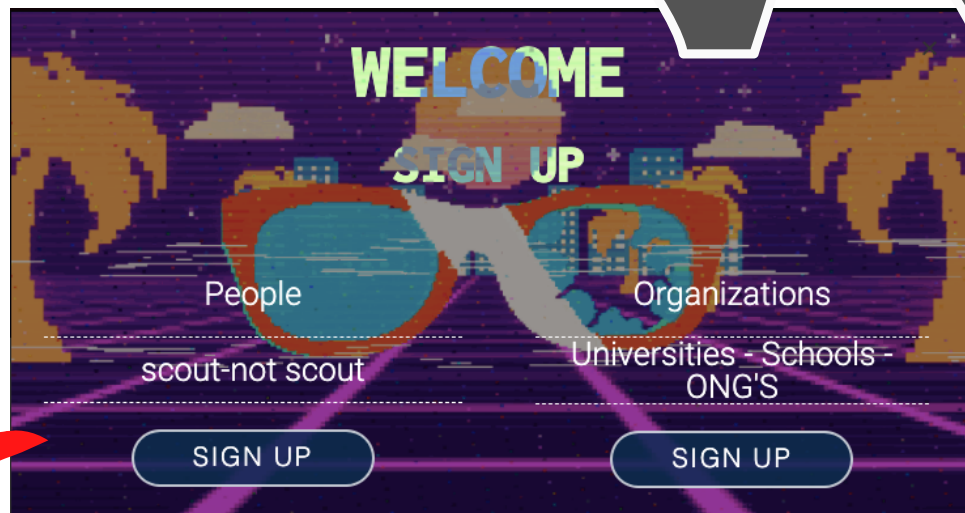

BLUE MODULE

Individual module

In this module, we suggest some individual activities, choose one of them and do it. Subsequently, you will be able to upload photos, videos and basic information about the execution of the activity.

The dynamics of the activities will be designed by three modules, the first one is the blue module (individual module), the second one is the red module (group module) and the last one is the purple module where people can develop in a dynamic and playful way their own activity.

RED MODULE

Group module

In this module, we suggest some group activities, choose one of them and do it. Subsequently, you will be able to upload photos, videos and basic information about the execution of the activity.

Remember that in order to obtain your diploma and unlock the next module, you will have to present proof of completing the activities.

PURPLE MODULE

Free module

In this module, you will be able to carry out activities freely, remember that you must be creative when executing it. In order to obtain your fourth and last diploma, you will have to present proof of completing the activities.

This is the last diploma that certifies you as a "campaigner" to ban Assassin Robots. After obtaining it, you will be able to acquire your badge at the Scout store in your country.

Considering that every time you unlock a module, you'll get a diploma.

It is important to note that you will always be able to check your levels, continue to the subsequent modules and download your certificate in "your levels", a button that will appear at the top left of the website.
